This a fully designed project (Design Bid Build). Construct a Ground Transport Equipment Building Complex. Project includes a vehicle maintenance shop (ground transport equipment building), organizational storage building, organizational vehicle parking, vehicle wash platform, vehicle loading dock, petroleum, oils and lubricants (POL) storage, and other hazardous waste/material storage. The vehicle maintenance facility will include mechanical and electrical rooms, telecommunications, HVAC, fire detection and sprinkler suppression systems, building information systems, intrusion detection system (IDS) installation, integrated energy, monitoring and control system (EMCS) connected to the base monitoring systems, and the installation of fire alarm systems. Supporting facilities will include connection to all utilities, lighting, paving, parking areas, sidewalks, curbs and gutters, rainwater harvesting systems, and signage. Heating and air conditioning will be provided by self-contained systems.

The estimated magnitude of project is between \$25,000,000 and \$100,000,000. This solicitation is UNRESTRICTED and all responsive and responsible parties are invited to submit a bid. The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code is 236220 Commercial and Institutional Building

OPTION DESCRIPTIONS

BID OPTION 1 consists of demolition of building 68048 in the existing EPG Motor Pool. See sheet CD104 for additional information.

2. **BID OPTION 2** consists of all covered parking structures and associated top mounted photovoltaic panels within the overflow parking lot. It does not include the new A/C parking lot as this is part of the Base Bid. Only the covered parking structure and all items associated with the PV system are part of Option 2. See sheets CS102 and CS107 for the location of the overflow parking lot. See the electrical sheets for additional information on the PV system.

3. **BID OPTION 3** consists of construction of the east end (approximately 6900 square feet) of the GTEF facility building referred to as the "Training Wing" of the facility. See civil, architectural, structural, mechanical, plumbing, electrical, communication for revision required due to elimination of this part of the building. If the bid option is not awarded, the concrete skirt surrounding the building shall be revised and the remaining footprint of the building area not constructed shall be paved with the same resin modified pavement as the surrounding maintenance yard, as shown on sheet CS102.

4 **BID OPTION 4** consists of the construction of a second wash rack on the east end of the facility maintenance yard. This option includes the concrete paved pad, wash ramp structure, and wastewater collection system including 16 linear feet of sewer line connecting the wash rack drain to the sanitary sewer system. If this bid option is not awarded, the concrete footprint of the wash rack shall be paved with the same resin modified pavement as the surrounding maintenance yard. See sheet CG103 for grading of the area if the option is not awarded.

5. **BID OPTION 5** consists extending the facility maintenance yard to the west by 150 feet. The bid option includes an approximately an additional 57,300 square feet of resin modified paved area on the west side of the maintenance yard. The bid option includes additional fencing and curb and gutter as shown on sheet CS103A. If the bid option is not awarded the perimeter fence, curb and gutter on the north side of the yard, pavement marking, and the northwest exit drive shall be as shown on sheet CS103. See the electrical drawings for maintenance yard lighting revisions if the bid option is not

awarded.

6. **BID OPTION 6** consists of the construction of the hazmat storage building on the southeast side of the maintenance yard. If this bid option is not awarded the footprint of the hazmat building shall be paved with the same resin modified pavement as the surrounding maintenance yard and graded to drain toward the south at 1 %.

7. **BID OPTION 7** consists of the construction of the POL storage building on the southeast side of the maintenance yard. If this bid option is not awarded the footprint of the pol storage building shall be paved with the same resin modified pavement as the surrounding maintenance yard to drain toward the south at 1%.

8. **BID OPTION 8** consists of the construction of the Organizational Storage Building on the south side of the maintenance yard. If this bid option is not awarded the footprint of the Organizational Storage Building shall be paved with the same resin modified pavement as the surrounding maintenance yard and graded to drain toward the south at 1%.
