Bidder has reviewed the Work contemplated in the Construction Documents and fully understands the scope of that Work. Bidder further acknowledges that, if awarded the Bid, its proposal shall be the basis for entering into the Construction Contract with the Client, in substantially the same form as contained in the Project Manual.

Bidder acknowledges that the General Conditions for the Project are an integral part of the Contract Documents and that the General Conditions

have been read, understood and accepted by Bidder. Bidder understands and agrees not to disclaim knowledge of the meaning and effect of any term or provision of the General Conditions or Special Conditions and agrees to strictly abide by their meaning and intent.

Bidder Acknowledges that the contract requires the work to be completed by no later than **Three Hundred Ninety-Three (393)** working days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed. Bidder further acknowledges that time is of the essence in the performance of the Work contemplated herein and that the Construction Contract, General Conditions and Special Conditions provide for (A) liquidated damages in the amount of **One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500)** for each working day of delay until substantial completion of the Work and (B) liquidated damages in the amount of **One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500)** per day of delay for completion of all punch list items.

Bidder has notified the Client in writing of any discrepancies, omissions or ambiguities in (1) the Construction Documents and (2) in the terms and conditions of the Construction Contract, General Conditions. Bidder acknowledges that it is its responsibility to contact the Construction Manager, City and/or the Architect prior to the bid deadline to verify the existence of any clarifying addenda. Bidder acknowledges that the Client has the right to reject all bids and that this bid shall remain open and is irrevocable for a period of ninety (90) days unless an extended period is called for in the Notice to Contractors Calling for Bids.

Bidder acknowledges that the performance of the Work contemplated by the Construction Documents requires a “B” Contractor License issued by the California Department of Consumer Affairs, Contractors State License Board (CSLB). Furthermore, if Bidder is a corporation, that Bidder is a corporation in good standing in the state in which it is incorporated and is registered to do business in, and in good standing with, the State of California.

Bidder acknowledges that it is competent, knowledgeable and has the skill to perform the Work in accordance with the Construction Documents and that it is regularly engaged in the general class and type of Work called for in the Construction Documents.

Should Bidder fail or refuse to return executed copies of the Agreement, each of the certificates specified in the last page of this Bid Form, Certification of Insurance, and required

bonds to the Client within ten (10) calendar days of receiving notice of the award of the Contract to Bidder, the security may be forfeited to the Client as liquidated damages.

1. **Execution and Delivery of Agreement.** It is understood and agreed that if written notice of the award of this bid is mailed or delivered to the undersigned after the opening of the bid, and within the time this bid is required to remain open, or at any time thereafter before this bid is withdrawn, the undersigned will execute and deliver to Client an Agreement in the form attached hereto in accordance with the bid as accepted, and that the undersigned will also furnish and deliver to the Client the Performance Bond and Payment Bond along with all other documents specified on the last page of this Bid Form, all within the ten (10) calendar days after receipt of notification of award, and that the Work under the Agreement shall be commenced by the undersigned Bidder, if awarded the Contract on the date to be stated in the Client's Notice to Proceed delivered to CONTRACTOR, and shall be completed by CONTRACTOR in the time specified in the Contract Documents.

2. **Notice to Proceed.** Client may give a Notice to Proceed within ninety (90) Days of the award of the Bid by the Client. Once CONTRACTOR has received the Notice to Proceed, CONTRACTOR shall complete the Work in the time specified in the Agreement. In the event that the Client desires to postpone giving the Notice to Proceed beyond this ninety (90) Day period, it is expressly understood that with reasonable notice to CONTRACTOR, Client may postpone giving the Notice to Proceed. It is further expressly understood by CONTRACTOR that CONTRACTOR shall not be entitled to any claim of additional compensation as a result of the postponement of giving the Notice to Proceed. If CONTRACTOR believes that a postponement will cause a hardship to it, CONTRACTOR may terminate the Contract with written notice to the Client within ten (10) Days after receipt by CONTRACTOR of Client's Notice of Postponement. It is further understood by CONTRACTOR that in the event that CONTRACTOR terminates the Contract as a result of postponement by the Client, the Client shall only be obligated to pay CONTRACTOR for Work performed by CONTRACTOR at the time of notification of postponement.
