This Addendum No. 5 (32 pages in total) forms an essential part of the contract documents by revising the following:

#### 5A CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

#### 5A-1 00100 – NOTICE INVITING BIDS

Revise the first sentence to reflect a revised bid opening date and time of 2:00 PM on November 13, 2025:

The City of Santee ("City") will receive sealed bids for the Santee Community Center at the Office of the City Clerk, Santee City Hall, Building 3, 10601 Magnolia Avenue, Santee, California 92071, no later than 2:00 PM on November 13, 2025, at which time or thereafter said bids will be opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened.

#### 5A-2 00700 - Special Conditions

Article 44. Mobilization

Revise Section b. Item 7. to remove the requirements to provide telephone and telephone appurtenances:

Providing and maintaining the field office trailers for the Contractor and the Engineer, complete, with all specified furnishings and utility services including computer and printer, and copying machine.



#### 5A-3 00700 - Special Conditions

Article 44. Mobilization

Revise Section b. Item 8. to remove requirements to provide telephone and fax machines:

Providing on-site communication facilities for the Owner and the Engineer, including high-speed internet.

#### 5A-4 00750 - Special Conditions

#### 2. MILESTONE SCHEUDLING/PROJECT PHASING

Section B. PHASE 2 – COMMUNITY CENTER BUILDING, PARKING LOT AND SURROUNDING SITE IMPROVEMENTS:

Delete the first paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following:

Upon completion of the Phase 1 Improvements, the Contractor will be permitted to begin the Phase 2 improvements which includes the Community Center Building, eastern parking lot, utility and surrounding site improvements. The Contractor will be granted any remaining working days for the Phase 1 Improvements in addition to the Phase 2 working days as additional time to complete the entire project.

#### 5A-5 00750 - Special Conditions

Section 7. Biological Resources, Monitoring and Mitigation Measures Add the following paragraph:

The Contractor shall be responsible for all costs associated with the qualified biologist and biological monitor as well as all monitoring and mitigation costs including but not limited to, all required inspection, meetings, staff training, boundary delineation, avian nesting survey consistent with this the requirements of this section and as outlined in the Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration, prepared by Dudek (Attachment F).

#### 5A-6 00750 – Special Conditions

Section 8. Archaeological Monitoring and Reporting Add the following paragraph:

The Contractor shall be responsible for all costs associated with the qualified archeologist or archaeological monitor working under the direct supervision of a qualified archaeologist as well as all monitoring and mitigation costs including but not limited to, staff training, all required ground disturbing observations, inspection, meetings, preparation of logs, preparation and submission of reports, and appropriate treatment of resources should they encountered on the site as stated within the requirements of this section and as outlined in the Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration, prepared by Dudek (Attachment F).

#### 5A-7 00750 - Special Conditions

Section 9. Native American Monitor Add the following paragraph:

The Contractor shall be responsible for all costs associated with the Native American Monitor of Kumeyaay decent for all ground disturbing operations.

#### 5A-8 00750- Special Conditions

11. Geology & Soil Mitigation Measures Add the following paragraph:

The Contractor shall be responsible for all costs associated with the qualified paleontologist as described in this section and shall be responsible for all staff training, observation, monitoring and preparation of a Paleontological Resources Impact Mitigation Report should resources be encountered.

Keynote 8 - Stated text is revised to provide the following clarification for basis of design for solar system without reissuing the drawing:

Basis of design for solar system on the roof is to provide a minimum of 2.0 watts/SF of building as stated in the Special Conditions (Photo Voltaic System Deferred Submittal). Notation regarding 18kW and conductor sizes shall be disregarded. Conductor size and circuit breaker disconnect for SWBD1 for the PV system shall be determined with the deferred submittal.

## 5C-14 Drawing Sheet C1.9 - TRAFFIC SINGAGE AND STRIPING PLAN Signing and Striping Notes

Note 1. Delete and replace with the following due to incorrect reference for thermoplastic striping without reissuing the drawing:

All striping, markings and legends shall be reflectorized painted striping per Caltrans standards.

#### 5D RFI RESPONSES

The following items are responses to received RFI's for the project:

5D-1 Question: I'm assuming this project is Prevailing Wage. But, are Federal funds invested? Or is it just State/local prevailing wages. No skilled labor requirements?

Response: No Federal Funds are included in this contract, and this project is a Prevailing Wage project as stated in the contract documents.

5D-2 Question: Keynote 08.27 on sheet A2.21 is called out as a Bi-Fold Transaction Window. Is there any additional information you can provide on this window? For example, elevation, spec section, finish, glass makeup, size, etc.

Response: Basis of design is 4 panel bi parting Arcadia 10000 series door w/ ADA channel at counter top. Provide GL-1 at window, finish to match the rest of the aluminum frames. Size is shown on 10/A8.21.

5D-3 Question: Please confirm which items are to be included in section 274116 from the FFE list other than Crestron and Shure.

Response: All items stated in specification section 17 41 16 shall be included. In the event an item has been duplicated, it shall be included in the contract which can be later deleted as a credit after award of contract. Provide all items to provide a fully functioning audiovisual system as required in the contract documents.

5D-4 Question: The specifications item 10 is calling for an Environmental Sound Mitigation Measures by building a 12' tall noise barrier and refers to the Mitigated Negative Declaration that shows a basic location but does not provide any length or details.

Please provide a detail of this sound wall, materials, thickness, depth of post, etc. For everyone to be bidding the same thing we need to know is this wall ½" plywood, is it on two sides or one side. Does it require sound blankets on one side or both sides. We need to know a total length of wall.

Response: The project's environmental documentation establishes the requirement for a 12-foot-tall temporary noise barrier to mitigate construction noise impacts on adjacent sensitive receptors. It is the Contractor's responsibility to develop and provide a complete design for the temporary sound wall to achieve the necessary level of noise attenuation consistent with the intent of Mitigation Measure MM-NOI-1.

5D-5 Question: The General conditions and temp facilities is calling for telephones, radio pagers, Answering machines and fax machines. I don't believe anyone uses fax machines these days. Everyone uses Cell phones for communications. Please wave the requirement for land line telephones, pagers, answering machines and fax machines.

Response: These requirements have been revised in this addendum.

5D-6 Question: Speaker count on drawings does not match the count in the FFE document, please specify the number of speakers that are needed and where they are to be installed.

Response: Attachment I – Fixtures, Furnishing & Equipment list has been updated.

5D-7 Question: There is no specified manufacture listed for displays. Please provide so we can bid accordingly.

Response: Provide Samsung S95F OLED with anti-glare, or approved equal.

5D-8 Question: Specifications list microphone but does not list manufacture or model. Please provide so we can bid accordingly.

Response: Provide Shure Model Number SM58 wireless microphones, or approved equal.

5D-9 Question: FFE lists 12 ceiling microphones. None are shown in drawings, please confirm installation locations

Response: These were included in error, remove from Attachment I – Fixtures, Furnishings & Equipment list.

5D-10 Question: FFE lists more video distribution decoders than there are displays. Please confirm amount and installation points for decoders on drawings

Response: Attachment I – Fixture, Furnishings & Equipment List has been revised to provide 10 decoders, on for each display and projection screen.

5D-11 Question: FFE lists cameras, but there is no indication as to where those are to be installed within the drawings. Please confirm so we can bid accordingly.

Response: One camera is to be provided at each display location for the audio visual system to provide multi use of the AV system.

5D-12 Question: FFE lists 6 amps, one per room. There is a total of 4 rooms when they are not combined. Please confirm what other 2 rooms the remaining amps should be used for.

Response: There are to be located outside, one for the outside patio deck and one for the upstairs event deck.

5D-13 Question: FFE lists (6) 7" Control panels. The drawings call for 10, please confirm correct count and locations

Response: Locations of control panels are correct, Attachment I – Fixtures, Furnishing and Equipment list has been corrected.

5D-14 Question: Please provide a full detail to build the Building Address Numbers, Sheet A5.11 – 10.52 Address numbers placed near the roofline, numbers shall be block style, 12" in height, black in color. What is the full detail how to manufacture the Building Address Numbers (10.52)?

Response: Refer to revised keynote clarifying building address numbers on sheet A5.11 issued as part of this addendum.

5D-15 Question: The key notes for the site plans showing striping & legends ( arrows & stop stencils) in industry standard traffic paint. However, in the side notes on the same page says all markings to be thermoplastic unless otherwise noted. Need to know if all parking lot markings are paint or thermoplastic.

Response: Provide paint striping per the striping notes. Reference to thermoplastic is shown in error.

5D-16 Question: There is a spec for window coverings, roller shades (Spec 12 24 13). Page A9.22 shows RS-1 is for Shades. However there are no markings on the floor plans, or RCP plans etc. for RS-1 Shades.

Response: Refer to revised RCP sheets issued as part of this addendum.

5D-17 Question: The recent adjustment of the bid submission time to 2:00 PM conflicts with other commitments we had already adjusted to accommodate the City of Santee bid submission. Would it be possible to move the bid due date by one or two business days to allow adequate time for submissions?

Response: The bid opening date has been revised with this addendum to November 13, 2025 at 2:00pm.

5D-18 Question: Is the sound barrier described in article 10 of the special conditions the responsibility of the rough carpenter trade? If so, please provide construction details illustrating the required method of assembly.

Response: The project's environmental documentation establishes the requirement for a 12-foot-tall temporary noise barrier to mitigate construction noise impacts on adjacent sensitive receptors. It is the Contractor's responsibility to develop and provide a complete design for the temporary sound wall to achieve the necessary level of noise attenuation consistent with the intent of Mitigation Measure MM-NOI-1.

5D-19 Question: Please confirm if the location of the sound barrier is as depicted in figure 11C in appendix E "Hazards Memorandum" which does not entirely match the description given in the special conditions.

Response: The location of the sound mitigation barrier is correct as shown on Figure 11C.

5D-20 Question: Reference 00750 - Special Conditions #10, pages 120-121. Please provide a cut through detail showing the required 12' tall noise barrier.

Response: The project's environmental documentation establishes the requirement for a 12-foot-tall temporary noise barrier to mitigate construction noise impacts on adjacent sensitive receptors. It is the Contractor's responsibility to develop and provide a complete design for the temporary sound wall to achieve the necessary level of noise attenuation consistent with the intent of Mitigation Measure MM-NOI-1.

5D-21 Question: Reference 00750 – Special Conditions #8, 9 & 7, pages 116-120. In addition to providing an Archaeologist and Native American Monitor, is the contractor also responsible for providing a biologist?

Response: Yes. The Contractor is responsible for providing a qualified biologist.

5D-22 Question: Reference Attachment I – Fixtures Furnishings and Equipment. FF & E List.

Referenced document states this list of equipment is to be provided and installed by the contractor. Please consider this to be an allowance in the bid to be furnished and installed by the owner, as would be typical.

It is more economical for the owner by avoiding the contractor's OH&P as well as allowing some flexibility for changes as products evolve over the course of construction, particularly with the IT equipment in the schedule.

Having the IT equipment in the schedule presents the opportunity to double up on the items and the cost. Additionally, most of the scheduled IT equipment is old, outdated, discontinued or lacking the information to price accurately. e.g.: The Dell r750 can range from \$1,200 to \$15,000 depending on how it's optioned.

Please provide a bid allowance for the FF&E. If it comes in cheaper than the allowance amount, the owner will get the savings.

Response: Provide all products as required in the contract documents. The total value of this equipment can be identified by the Contractor in the submitted schedule of values to the City.

5D-23 Question: Please confirm that the cost of providing the 25-year solar generation performance warranty and 10-year panel/inverter warranties includes only the manufacturer's warranty cost, and does not require the Contractor to purchase separate umbrella coverage for these durations.

Notes: The intent was clarified to rely on manufacturer warranties, but confirmation is needed that the cost to the bidder is strictly limited to the manufacturer's inherent warranty and installation warranty, preventing hidden long-term liability costs.

Response: Yes. A separate umbrella coverage is not required for these durations.

5D-24 Question: Please clarify the specific color(s) and finish(es) required for the concrete paving, reconciling the three shades of gray shown on Sheet A1.21 with the "Medium Salt Finish" noted in Specification Section 32 13 13.

Notes: This conflict was noted in a prior RFI, and the response stated it would be addressed in Addendum 3. Resolution is critical for Division 03 and 32 bid packages.

Response: Refer to revised sheet A1.21 issued as part of this addendum.

5D-25 Question: Please specify the required tie-in detail and material compatibility documentation between the PVC Roofing air barrier system (Section 07 54 19) and the adjacent Standing-Seam Metal Roofing air barrier system (Section 07 41 13.16).

Notes: The roofing specs mention both PVC and Standing-Seam systems, and the need to coordinate the air barrier tie-in with adjacent systems. A specific detail or material specification for this critical transition is required for proper sealing and warranty compliance.

Response: Refer to detail added to sheet A10.41 issued as part of this addendum.

5D-26 Question: Please review 7/A10.91 metal fascia over PT Wood Fascia, the wood shows no connections. No reference on structural plans either. Please advise.

Response: Refer to structural detail 4/S0.92 for connection.

5D-27 Question: Please clarify W6G & W6A wall finish between AC & AD at segment A at Level 1.

Response: Refer to wall types on A10.12.

5D-28 Question: Since the exact nature and extent of dewatering for excavation (S0.01, Note 10) is unknown, please provide a defined metric, assumed quantity, or allowable dollar amount for dewatering to be carried in the bid, to ensure consistent bidding across all Contractors.

The City's intent for requiring the Contractor to be responsible for dewatering during construction is due to the site's close proximity to the Woodglen Vista Creek and being lower than the adjacent Cameron Family YMCA and northern parking lot and Riverwalk Housing Developments to the north which run-on accumulation of water during a rain event should be assumed during grading, building foundation and other excavations related to the work. Though the geotechnical report did not encounter ground water at boring elevations matching the site anticipated excavation limits, the City is providing notice that the Contractor shall assume some form of percolated surface waters from rain events or run-on waters may be encountered during the work.
